### Barwon Health Hosts HealthFusion Team Challenge PRO (HFTC<sup>PRO</sup>)

Barwon Health (Victoria) hosted Australia's first entirely health service-based HFTC<sup>PRO</sup> event on Monday May 2.

The event, held in Geelong, provided a unique educational opportunity, offering real life team-based problem solving for improved client care, while building skills of future health care leaders.
